# 3 rules of being a parent

- Your child's future is <u>your</u> <u>responsibility</u> not the coaches or counselors
- Let coaches coach. Let kids play because **they want to.**
- Your coach is there to <u>assist</u> you in finding a scholarship <u>not</u> find you a scholarship.

# There is no such thing as a 4 year Full Ride

- All scholarships are 1 year renewable deals.
- Attitude and Academics are critical.
- The goal should be to graduate college not just play ball!!!

## Scholarship Facts

- 3% of high school student athletes receive a scholarship.
- Less than 1% receive a 4 year D1 scholarship.
- 26% of students entering college on an athletic scholarship are no longer on a scholarship entering their sophomore year.
- 80% of scholarship/ Financial aid opportunities are not at the D1 level.

## Scholarship Facts

- Not all D1 and D2 schools provide scholarships
- D3 schools are non-scholarship but offer a lot of financial aid.
- NAIA does provide Scholarships.
- Junior Colleges (JUCO'S) provide scholarships.

#### More Facts

- 80% of financial assistance is realized <u>after</u> Jan 1, of the senior year.
- Most recruiting is done by November of your Senior year.
- By your senior year you should be well on your way to being recruited and having conversations with coaches or you might want to consider other options.
- The name game
  - Do you want to play or do you want to watch
  - You have 4 years to play the sports you want
- Go to college to learn. Not to play sports. Find the right Mix.

#### Considerations

- Ask yourself this question:
  - If the college you are researching did not offer your sport, would you consider attending that school?
- This is not a 4 year decision. This is a 40-50 year decision!! Will change the rest of your life.
- Cooperative Education:
  - Have a real job and gain real work experience, internship
  - Just Ask

# Social Networking:

- Never Face-book or Twitter when You are Bitter!!!!
- Can affect your entire recruiting experience.
- Colleges have people that can research you online.
- Beware of pictured or videoed activities. This also can be researched and will be used.
- Don't become a cell phone or camera victim.
- Don't become a statistic, every decision has a consequence!!! Good or Bad

#### National Letter of Intent:

- Provides a one year guarantee
- Stops the recruiting process. You and the college are now married.

### Recruiting Services:

- If you want something done right Do it yourself (with your coaches Assistance)
- Need a video
- Have the grades
- Get in contact with coaches.
- Play club ball
- FASFA needs to be filled out.

#### How do I do it>>

- You-Tube Shoot yourself. Whole game, <u>not</u> just highlights.
- Judged by quality of play not quality of tape.
- Student profile; Without falsifying information.
  Honest. Accomplishments,
- E-mail to coach keep in contact.
- NCAA Core Course GPA

# NCAA Clearinghouse - The Eligibility Center

- WWW.eligibilitycenter.org
  - There is a Fee = \$65
  - Transcript will not be reviewed until the end of your junior year.
  - Transcript will not be reviewed unless a NCAA college has you on heir <u>submitted recruiting list.</u>
  - This is a list of kids the coaches are interested in recruiting.
  - Ask your recruiter: Am I on your eligibility center submitted recruiting list???
  - If yes you are good to go. If no you do not have a shot.
  - You cannot take an official recruiting visit until you register with the EC.
  - Specific Core Courses and SAT/ACT requirements. Check the Eligibility Center Web site for up to date INFO.
