(You may request that your child be placed with **one** of the grade level teachers.) We will make every effort to honor valid academic requests, but cannot guarantee that everyone's request will be met. Thank you for entrusting your child to our professional educators and The Pueblo City School District.

Our staff continues to work diligently to provide your child with a quality education as well as support. We still need your assistance in communicating to your child the importance of returning completed homework assignments, planners being signed, daily attendance, following all school rules and participating in all school and class activities. ATTENDANCE

Please remember that we are in session until June 1, 2023 and it is imperative that we continue to have our students here promptly on a daily basis!!! It is imperative that we as a TEAM continue to strive for our goal of 98 % daily attendance. Students can only learn if they are in attendance and are allowed to be exposed to instruction, which increases student achievement. Also, please refrain from pulling your son/daughter prior to 3:05 PM unless, of course, you have medical appointments. Tardiness has become a concern and we would appreciate your cooperation in assisting in having your son/daughter in attendance promptly at 7:45 AM. Students with chronic tardy issues will lose lunch recess privileges and will phone home to notify parents.

We have experienced a decline in our daily attendance and would like to request your assistance!!! I would like to remind parents that if your son/daughter is absent it is necessary to call to excuse them. Colorado State Legislature passed Senate Bill No. 140 dealing with School Attendance, requires a truancy report to be filed with our courts if your son/daughter consistently is absent without an excuse. We would like to avoid this if possible so please assist with our request and contact either Mrs. Guerrero or Mr. Torres before 9:30 AM.

PARENT/GUARDIAN VISITATION

Please continue to assist us in making sure our school is a safe environment by checking in with the office and using your ID with our Raptor system as well as getting your visitor's pass. We want to ensure our students that everyone in the building is accounted for and encourage visitors/volunteers, but need to have a record of them in the office prior to visiting the classroom.

SCHOOL HOURS

We need your help! We have no morning supervision on the school grounds prior to 7:40 a.m. Please do not drop your child off prior to 7:40 a.m. unless they are participating in morning tutoring with their teacher.

PARENT DROP OFF AND PICKUP

In order to pick-up or drop-off your child; the preferred parent pick-up and drop off on 9th Street using our loop and 10th street heading east. PLEASE!!! DO NOT PICK-UP OR DROP OFF YOUR CHILD IN THE BUS LOADING/UNLOADING ZONE. Our police department will patrol school zone areas and will strictly enforce all traffic laws. Please remember that the safety of our students should be our number one priority, a matter of convenience should not take precedence.
