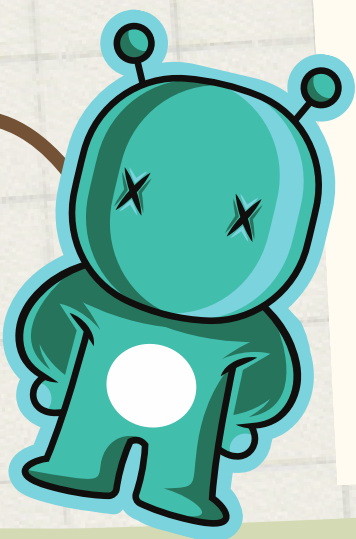
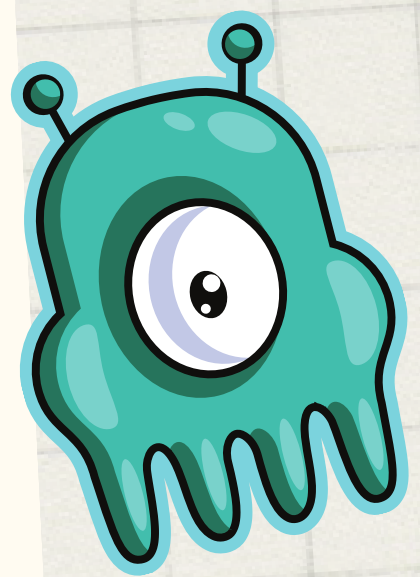
Collins has demonstrated putting first things first by coming home right after school and reading her AR books. Her love for reading showed that she truly cares about excelling in her academics.

2nd Grade



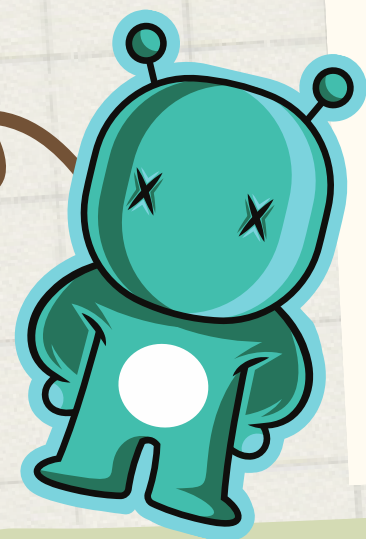
